EXCERPT FROM THE GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Lift passes are personal tickets and are therefore not transferable.
- Under our general terms of pricing, "families" refers to the parents plus children and teenagers¹⁾ living with both parents in a joint household.
- The misuse of lift passes will result in the revocation of the lift ticket and the exclusion from transportation. Furthermore, a fine of at least € 50.00 and the full fee for a day ticket will be charged. Even an attempt to transfer a lift pass to another person is considered to be misuse.
- Key card required. The deposit of € 3.00 will be refunded when you return the card undamaged. Cards for day tickets, different regulations in each region.
- Photo generally required for 8 days or more. Photo machines at all main ticket offices.
- Lift tickets/passes available from all ticket offices.
- Multi-day ski passes can also be purchased in advance and used after 3pm the day before their validity commences. Exception: Tauernseilbahn cable cars in Haus/Ennstal.
- Switch Access watches and key gloves can no longer be used as lift passes.
- There is no refund for a day and half-day ticket in the case of bad weather, shut-down of individual services, closing of ski runs or ski areas, danger of avalanches, premature equipment or interruptions in operation.
- Separate rates for tobogganing in the evening and for night skiing.
- Prices subject to change. Errors and misprints excepted.

- A charge is payable for rescue following accidents on the ski slopes (displayed at the ticket offices).
- Please observe our General Terms of Pricing and Transport Conditions at the individual lifts (displayed at the ticket offices and lifts).
- Information on additional lift passes (e.g. special periods and hourly tickets) available from the ticket offices.
- Security note: All slopes are closed from 5pm until 6am (please take note of opening times of slopes of each respective ski area), with the exception of the clearly marked and floodlit after-dark ski slopes. In order to offer you an unforgettable skiing experience, slope preparation work is carried out and snow-making machines are in operation at this time (warning: ropes across the slope).
- In the low season, and if there is not enough snow cover, some of the lifts and runs may have to be closed.
- By purchasing a personal identity ski pass, the card holder agrees to the automatic recording of personal data. These are electronically recorded and processed for validating purposes in order to avoid the misuse of ski passes as well as for the purpose of customer service, but will be deleted three years after the last contact with the customer at the latest.
- The purchase of a ski lift ticket entitles the passenger to use the skiing areas that are included in the Ski amade. As the member companies of Ski amade are legally independent, a possible liability for incidents resulting from or during the operation and use of the ski lifts and cable cars, as well as of the slopes, is solely the responsibility of the lift company in whose skiing area the incident occurred.

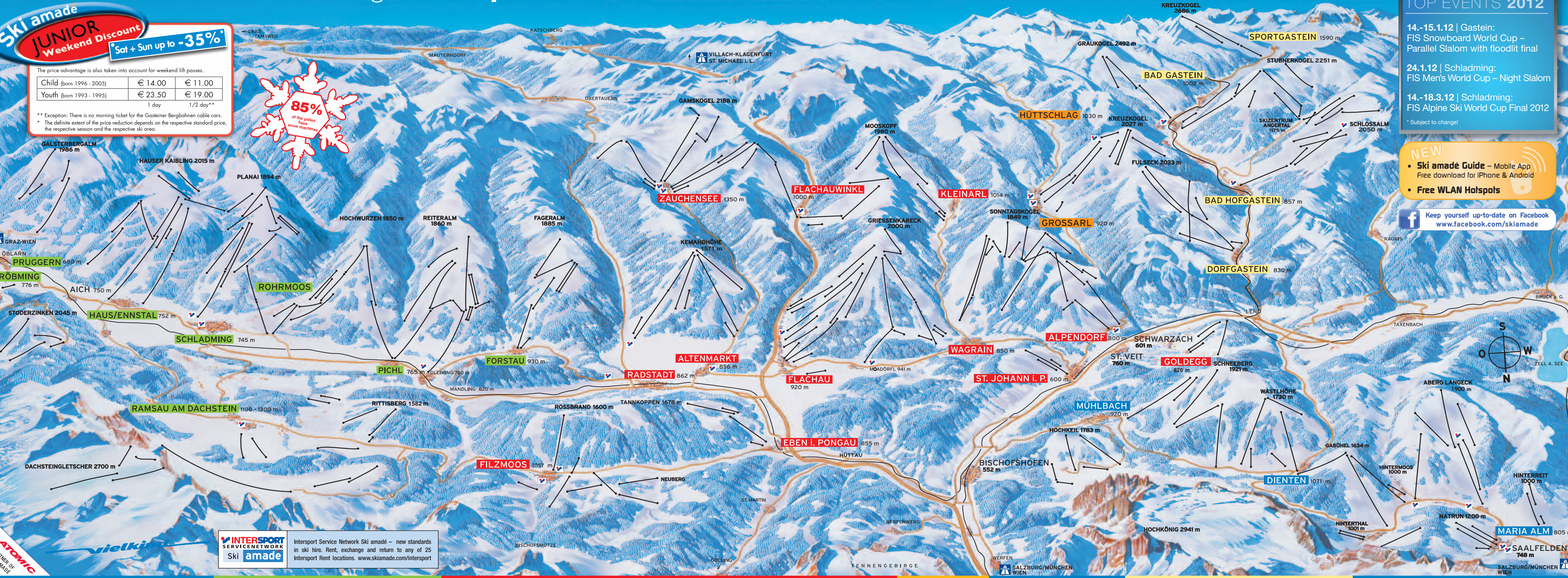

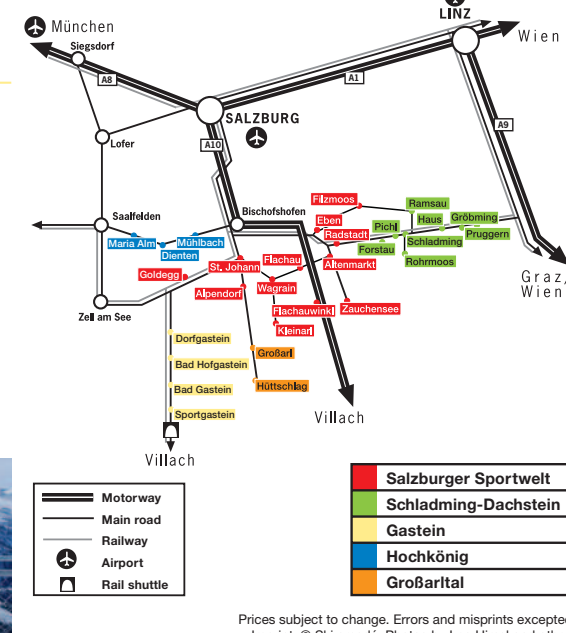
